Revisions

Members are expected, first of all to be faithful to the Scriptures, and in all the duties essential to the Christian life; and also attend continuously the services of this church; to give consistently for its support with tithing 10% of gross income no less than \$500.00 per year and no less than \$125.00 per quarter, along with general offerings, and other special assessments; to support the missionary activities of the Church and to share enthusiastically in the work and planned programs of the Church.

Section 5 Revisions

All church members are expected to follow the Biblical principles of love, commitment, and consistency in service to the ministries of the church. It is essential that all church members practice faithful discipleship, loving fellowship, and cheerful stewardship through giving in order to remain a member in good standing. Members in good standing should consistently attend Sunday School, Morning worship, and Bible Study. A church member is considered "inactive" if a member fails to commit to consistency of the above principles for a period longer than of 90 days. Inactive members will not be able to serve in any ministries or leadership positions in the church. Exceptions will be given to church members that are incapacitated, experiencing family illnesses, college students, and employees working out of town. To maintain membership, persons must consistently abide by the duties and requirements outlined in Section 3 and Section 5 of this constitution
